CLASS: Beg/Inter Acrylic Painting

INSTRUCTOR: Terry Eden

SUPPLIES:

PALETTE: (any surface to mix your paints on)
China or paper plate, or paper pad (oil proof paper), or plastic palette.

WATER CONTAINER: (anything that takes water)
Jar or plastic cup

ACRYLIC PAINTS: (basic selection that can be added to)
Cadmium yellow, ultramarine blue, cadmium red, permanent rose, liquitex Hooker's green deep hue permanent and burnt under.

BRUSHES: (gradually add a selection of types and sizes to the ones below)
5/8 inch wide stiff hair flat (square brush) and soft hair round pointed hair about 7/8 long.

SUPPORT: (card and board can also take acrylic paint)
12" x 16" canvas paper pad and/or stretched canvas.

PAPER TOWELS

This basic list is to get started. We will get to know other materials as we progress and gradually add to your supply to suit your needs.

ACTIVITIES: Still life, landscape, abstraction, placement, color mixing, scaling, composition, brush techniques, mediums.
